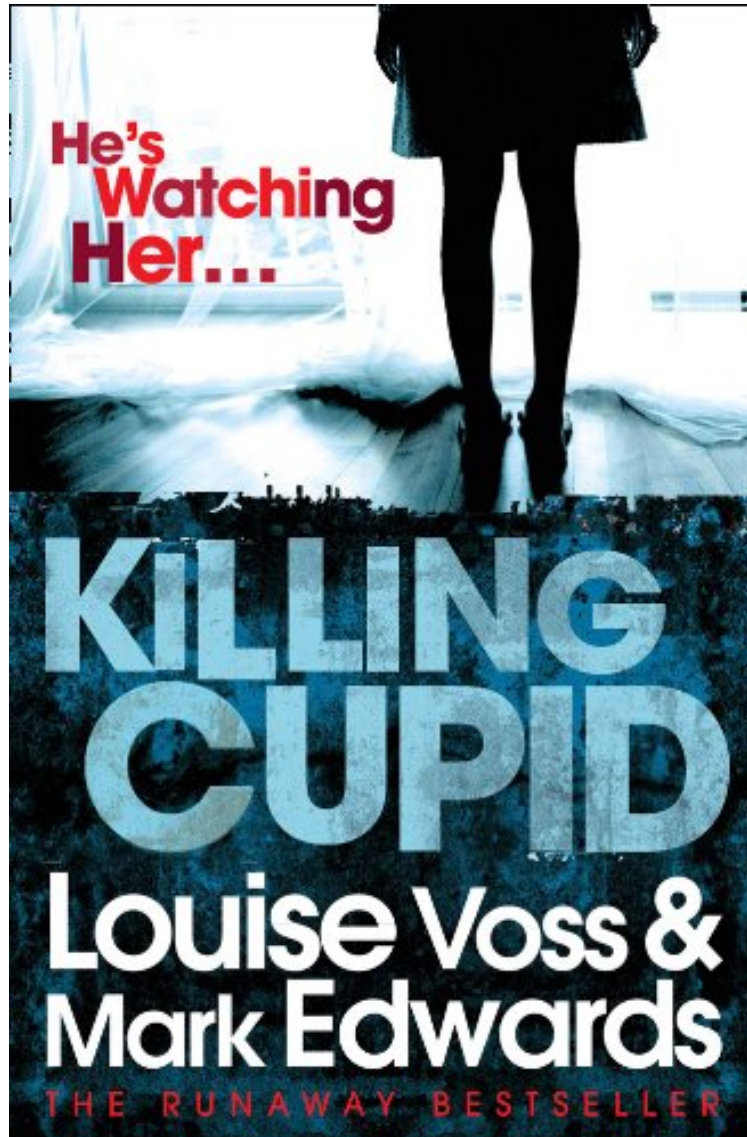

Im Laufe der Geschichte leidet man erst mit Siobhan mit, danach jedoch wird einem unser erst unsympathischer Taugenichts Alex immer sympathischer, da Siobhan durchdreht so geht man selbst durch ein Wechselbad der Gefühle: Gar nicht schlecht, wenn das ein Buch schafft.
