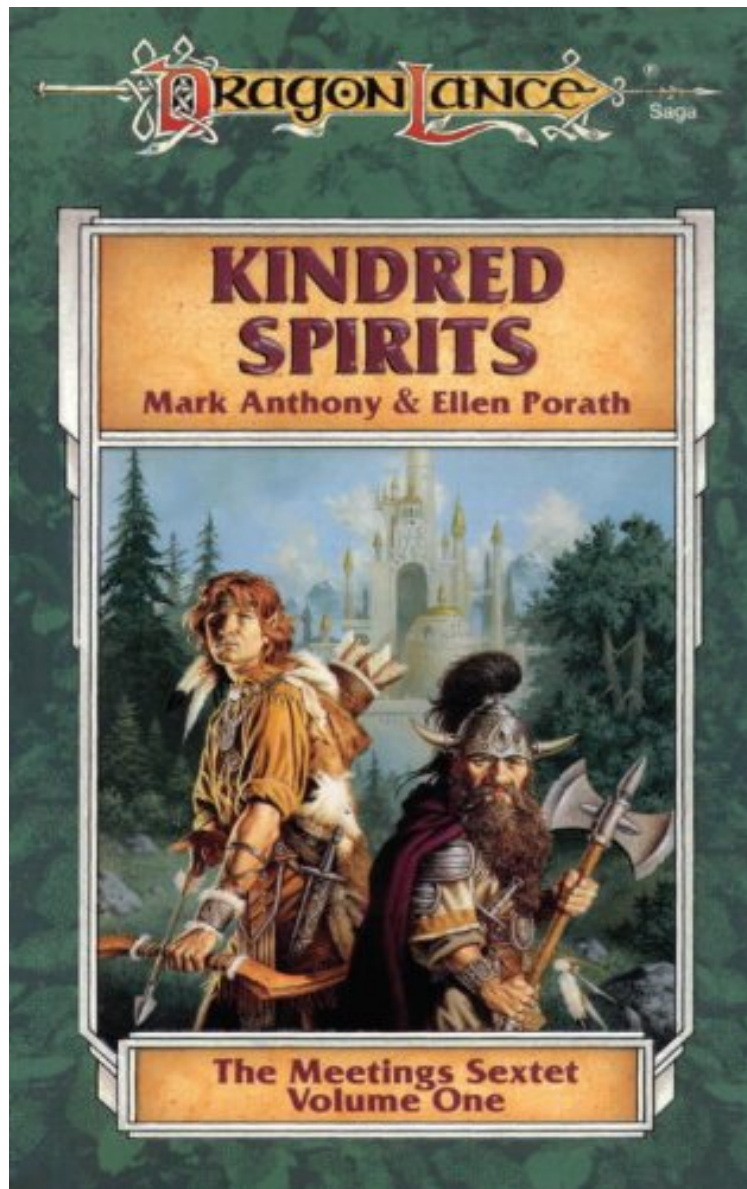

Auf Einladung der Stimme der Sonnen kommt der Zwerg Flint Feuerschmied in die Elfenhauptstadt Qualinost, um dort einige Kunstwerke anzufertigen. Dort freundet sich Flint mit dem Halbelfen Tanis an, der aufgrund seiner Abstammung ein Auenseiter in der Elfengesellschaft ist. Als Tanis in eine Palastintrige verwickelt wird, ist Flint der Einzige, der ihm helfen kann, seine Unschuld zu beweisen. Obwohl die Geschichte nicht besonders originell ist, man erahnt beispielsweise ziemlich früh, wer hier der wahre Bsewicht ist, macht es dennoch Spaß sie zu lesen. Flint und Tanis werden von den Autoren ziemlich originalgetreu dargestellt, besonders die Isolation von Tanis zwischen all den reinblütigen Elfen ist sehr gut nachvollziehbar. Bei Solostaran bzw. der Stimme der Sonnen haben sich Anthony Porath jedoch ziemlich vertan. Statt des hochmütigen, fremdenfeindlichen Herrschers, wie man ihn aus der Chronik kennt, findet sich hier ein sympathischer Elf, der Tanis trotz seiner Herkunft liebt und zudem Freundschaft mit einem einfachen Hgelzweg schließt. Ansonsten passt sich die Geschichte jedoch gut in den bereits bestehenden Kanon ein, so wird Lauranas Schwärmerei für Tanis und die daraus resultierenden Probleme zu einem bedeutsamen Aspekt der Handlung. Fazit: Für Fans von Tanis und Flint ein leichtgewichtiger, aber stimmiger Roman, der einiges über die Vergangenheit der beiden beliebten Charaktere enthüllt. What I enjoyed about this book, ESPECIALLY after reading I, II, III Chronicles; I, II, III Legends; Dragons of Summer Flame, and The Legend of Huma, was that it was not all blood and gore. That can just get way too depressing and ridiculous after a while. This book, however, has a setting in the pleasant Qualinesti, where Flint pleasantly works for the Speaker of the Sun, and meets Tanis and Laurana (full name Lauralanthalasa hehe...) when they're really super young, like when Tanis is (in appearance) 14, and Laurana is 10, although Tanis is at the time 30, if I'm right. Then, Flint leaves Qualinost, being the bestest of friends w/ the Speaker of the Sun (!), and then comes back occasionally to visit, but the second part of the book doesn't start until 20 years later, when Flint is 40 and Tanis is around 20. Anyway, the setting is not all icky and everything is just a really nice read. It is a good book because it establishes the friendship of Flint and Tanis and gives the reader an idea of how close they are. I tell you, read this book first if you've never read a dragonlance book, because if you do, I promise that by the time you get to Chronicles, when Flint does, you will cry your eyes out! Well Written, But Flawed Von Dan Cuomo Anyone familiar with the original Heroes of the Lance will want to pick up a copy of Kindered Spirits. This first installment of the "Meetings" series tells the story of the early years shared by Flint and Tanis. The authors spend most of their time with Tanis as a youth and Flint as a veteran dwarf. Fans expecting to see lots of interaction between Tanis and Laurana will be disappointed, however. I had hoped to see a little bit more of their early life as a young lovers, but that's not the case here. Largely the events of this book detail Flint and Tanis's relationship, and their fight to prove Tanis innocent of murder. For the most part, the plot and story are sound. The events in this book fall nicely into place with Weiss and Hickman's original outlines of these characters' pasts. However, I feel the book ended too abruptly, failing to explain a good deal of the character's motivations. Furthermore, there was no aftermath following the climax of the story. The story just ended, then transplanted the characters out of the setting months later. While the guts of this book are fairly thorough, the ending was rushed, and left me unsatisfied.
