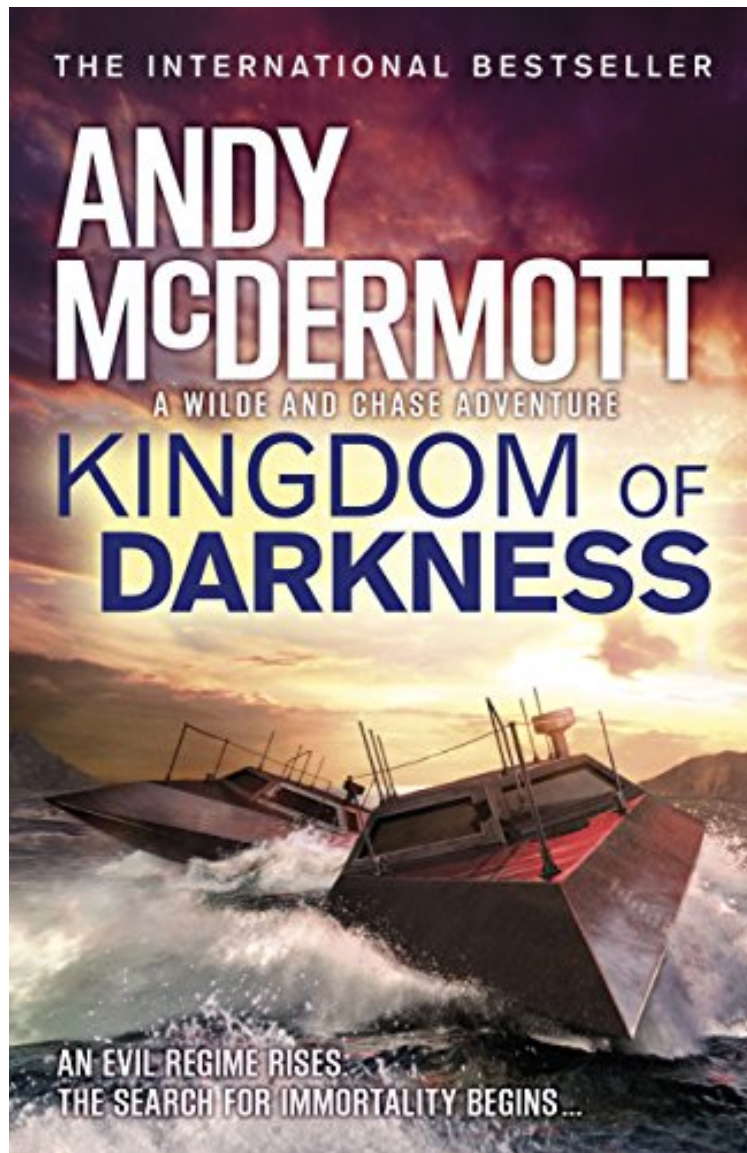

Von Lusa If you use parts of a foreign language in your story, and especially if that is part of your main plotline and therefore more or less important, you really should let a native speaker beta-read it. Or at least someone with a bit more than just basic vocabulary knowledge. The author regrettably didn't, which led to a dreadful reading experience and at times I felt as if he was taking the piss at Germans just because some of the sentences were so poorly translated that it seemed as if the author hadn't bothered to do much more research than running the phrases through Google translator.
