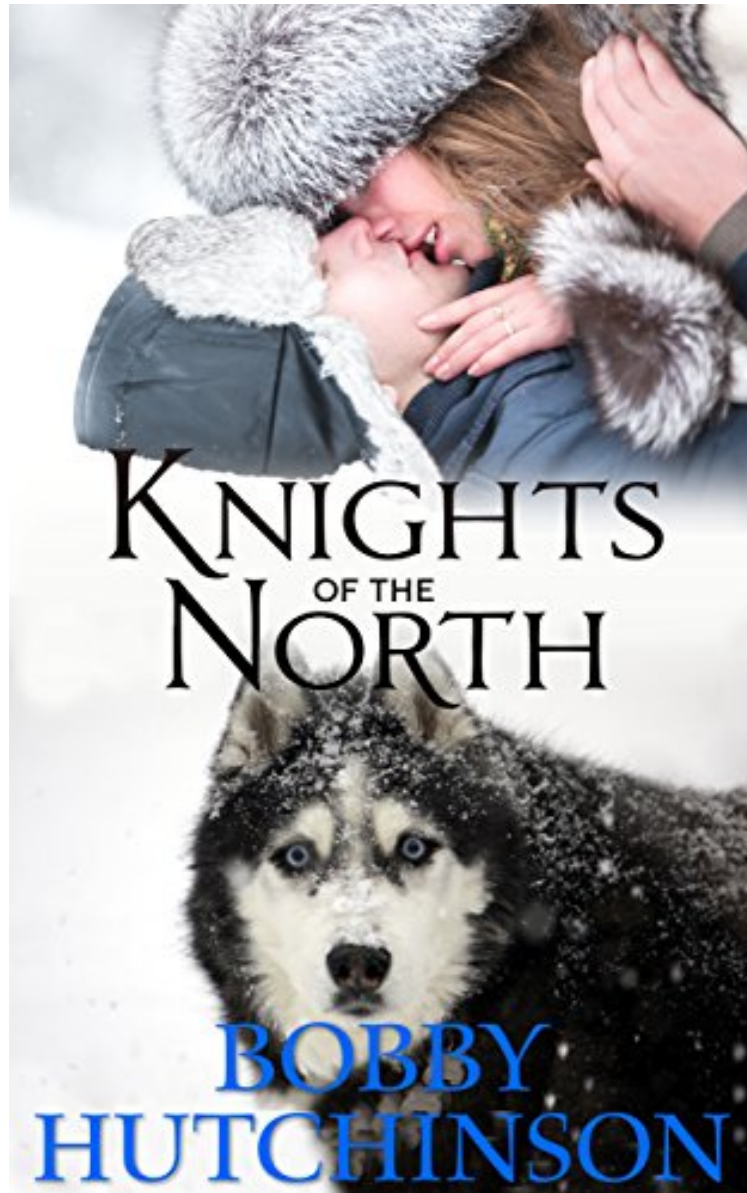

Denn zwei so reservierte Persönlichkeiten sollen so rasch aus sich herausgehen können? Nun ja, aber immerhin klappt das mit der Liebesgeschichte. Die Abenteuer habe ich irgendwie erst gar nicht gefunden. Es sei denn, man hält das Fahren eines Schneemobils bzw. Schneeraupe und eine einmalige Hundeschlittenfahrt für riesige Abenteuer.
