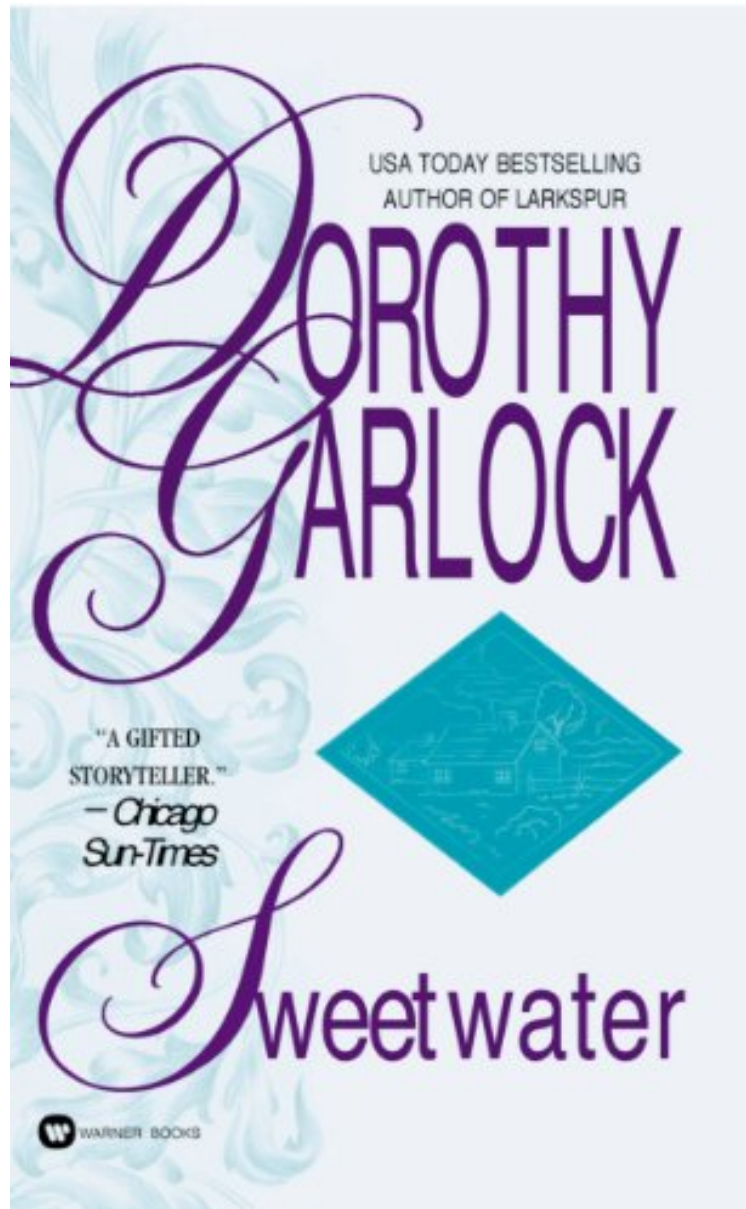

Charles is a religious fanatic, who physically and mentally abuses the children under the guise of piously raising them. Jenny kidnaps her two younger siblings and heads to the Wyoming Territory where she can not be expedited back to the states. Jenny begins to teach at the local Indian school. The Indian agent wants her to leave because of the nature of a will that will allow either the teacher to inherit a large spread if she stays or place the land up for auction (below market rates). Jenny also meets and falls in love with Trell McCall, a kind local rancher. However, before they can explore the direction and endurance of their relationship, they must survive all the machinations of the Indian agent, who will do anything to force Jenny off the land. Readers will enjoy this western romance due to the depth and inner strength to all the good guys (and gals).
