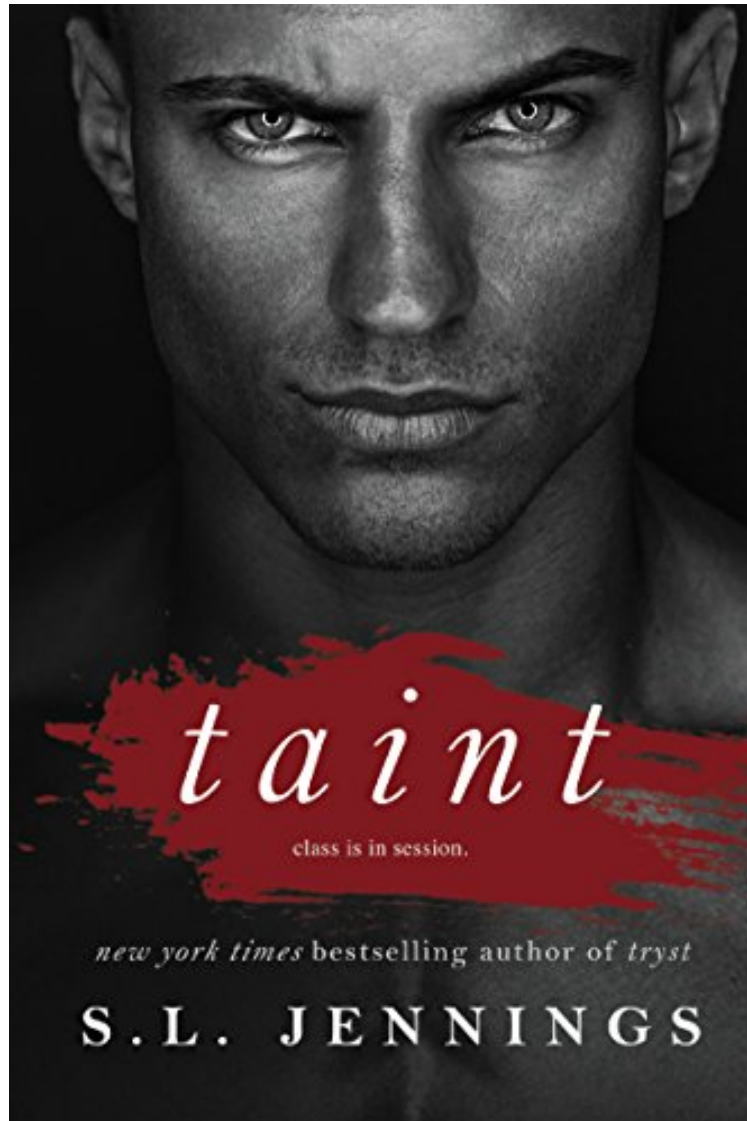

It is a relation to reality I really appreciate. The idea

that the male protagonist coaches married women how to seduce and satisfy their cheating husbands is priceless. Jennings' writing style is detailed and literary. I favor stories with troubled characters and a lot of emotionality and emotions. I love books that let me laugh, tear up and cry and I downgrade books that contain emotional topics but can't transport the emotions. Jennings' *Taint* isn't focus on the emotionality of the characters. Ally and Justice know and are used to the situation of cheating husbands and broken marriages. *Taint* is a story with a single storyline and Ally's and Justice's relationship in the center of the story. It has an interesting twist at the end of the book that I really liked. In my opinion the whole ending is great. The story is written in Justice Drake's first-person narrative. Most books tell the story in the female perspective or the narratives change between two narrators, *Taint* is one of the few books I read with only a male perspective. Justice's narrative adapts his personality and shows his current state of mind.
