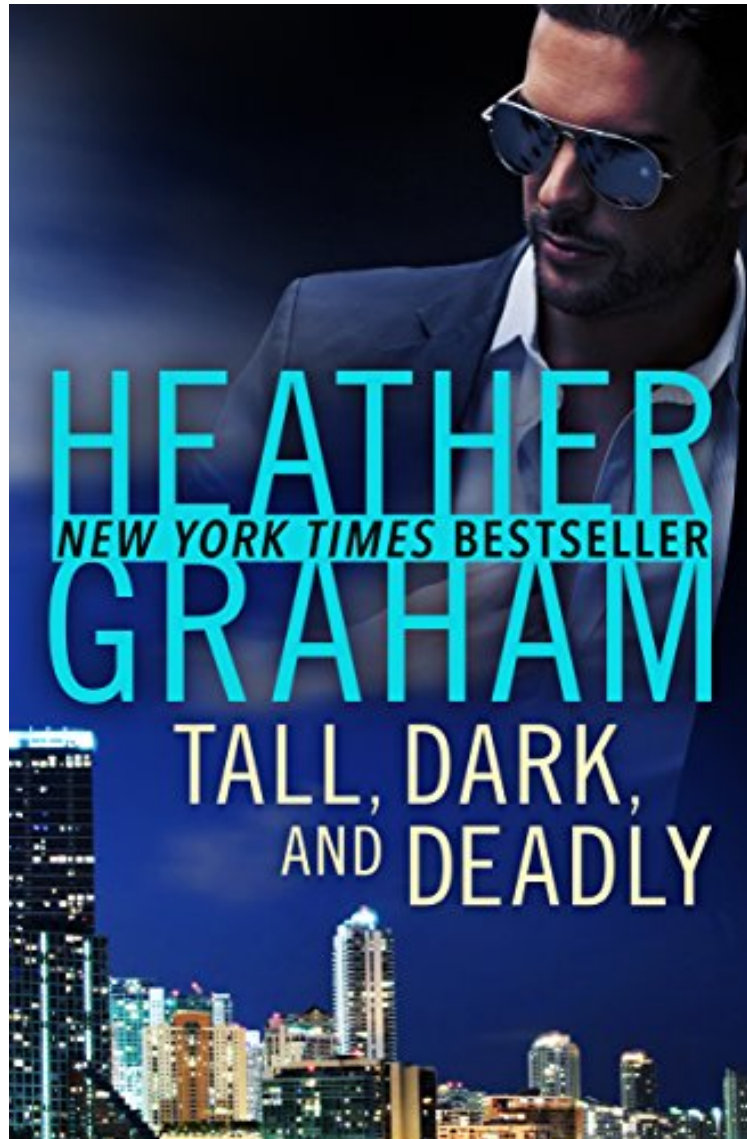

For some reason, this one did not live up to my expectations since DROP DEAD GORGEOUS left me gripping to the very end. This one is still a very good book with an interesting storyline.

However, at times I found it difficult to follow some of the dialogue. The dialogue was choppy, jumped around a lot, and did not flow easily. I did not find all the typos that the other reviewers mentioned. There were a few but they did not deter me away from the story. I did notice the inconsistencies, however, but probably would not have picked it up if it weren't for the reviewers here at AMAZON pointing it out. I did have a little bit of trouble with all the different characters, so I drew a flowchart of the 3 homes on the peninsula and how all the characters were related to the people living in the houses.
