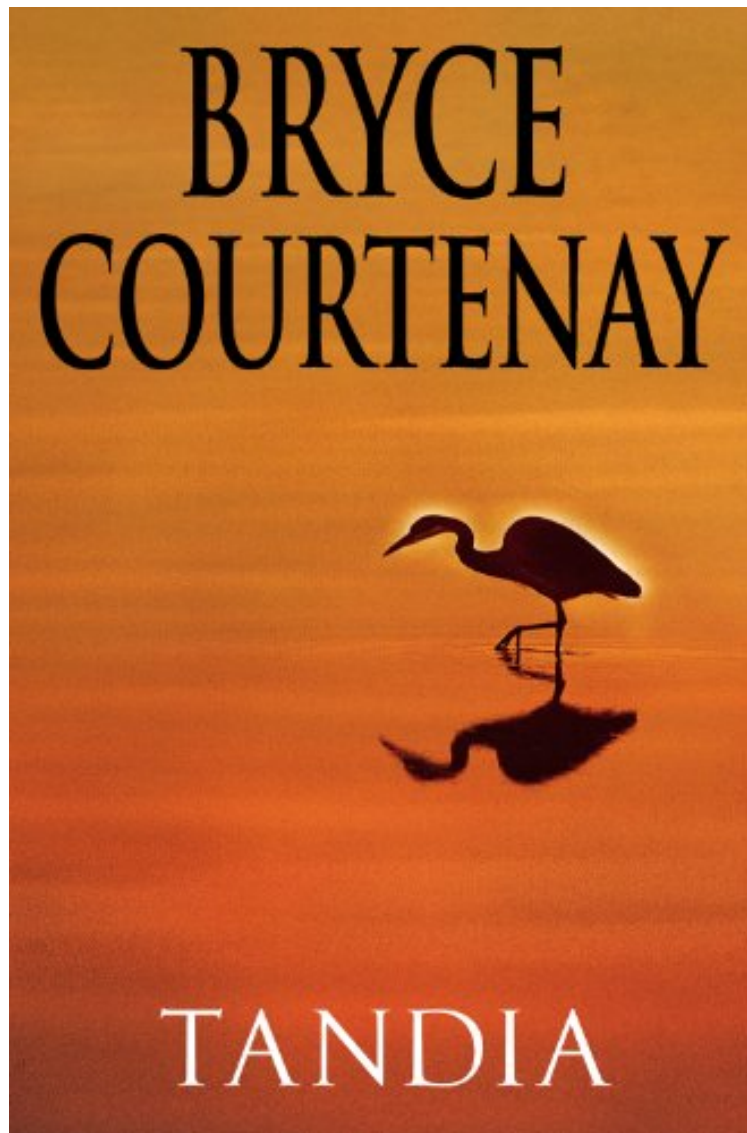

A woman "without a tribe" Von Melitta Spiess Tandia, of Indian-African origin, turns into a breath-taking beauty at the age of 15. When her father dies, she is suddenly exposed to the South African police brutality of the mid 20th century. She is rescued and allowed to finish high school and study law, hoping to fight for the rights of the black South Africans. This way she meets Peekay, a white South African who has devoted his life to the same battle. "Tandia" is the continuation of a story started in "The Power of One" where the youth of Peekay is described who is first bullied at school, then learns the methods of survival in an unfavourable environment by inner strength taught by an African medicine man and later by boxing. This is more than just a love story. It describes the South African struggle for freedom and justice using the example of the Tandia and her friends of all colours. It shows the discrimination of black and more so of people with mixed origin (without a tribe) in a society of apartheid. Although some coincidences are too fantastic to be true, it is a brilliantly told story and thrilling from the first to the last page.
