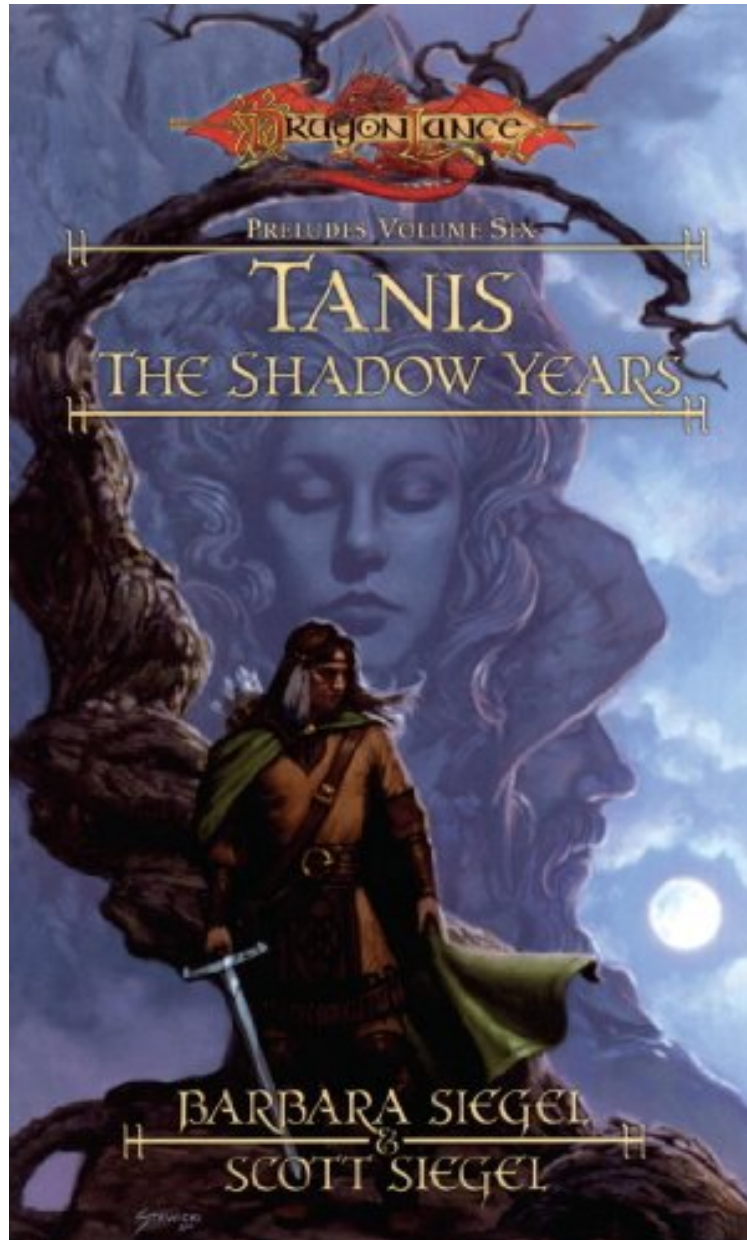

Like "Steel and Stone", this would have worked had the central character been someone other than our revered half elf. Despite doing their homework correctly, I felt the authors didn't portray Tanis in the right manner. I realise the story takes place 5 years prior to DoAT, but his personality and "way of thinking" (for lack of a better term) seem so fundamentally different, unable to capture the true charismatic nature which we come to expect. TtSY could have been a good read as there is a decent plot which is cleverly executed by the authors. The writing is concise and time isn't wasted, allowing the reader to remain focused. However, for all its merits, we cannot ignore the rudimentary flaw. It has a very interesting plot involving time travel, the realm of memories and coming to terms with one's own self. Its last few pages strike a nostalgic chord, especially for people who have ever wanted someone belonging to another person. This is not an epic story, though, and fails to live up to the hype that surrounds Tanis' disappearance into the mountains. In fact, this story covered little less than a month or so of the hero's 5 years of solitude. It ended saying Tanis' sojourn would have to wait for another telling. A Dissapointment for any True DragonLance Fan Von markley@erols.com I am a hardcore DL fan and was really looking forward to this book, seeing as how it was supposed to detail Tanis's life in the five years prior to Weis and Hickman's classic Chronicles trilogy (I refer to it as a 'trilogy' because I refuse to acknowledge "Dragons of Summer Flame," a cheezy attempt by the authors to revisit the world they'd created and, by doing so, destroying it forever). Unfortunately, the book delivers nothing: no memorable characters, no epic atmosphere, and a plot that is made all the worse by the fact that it has so much potential and they do nothing with it!
