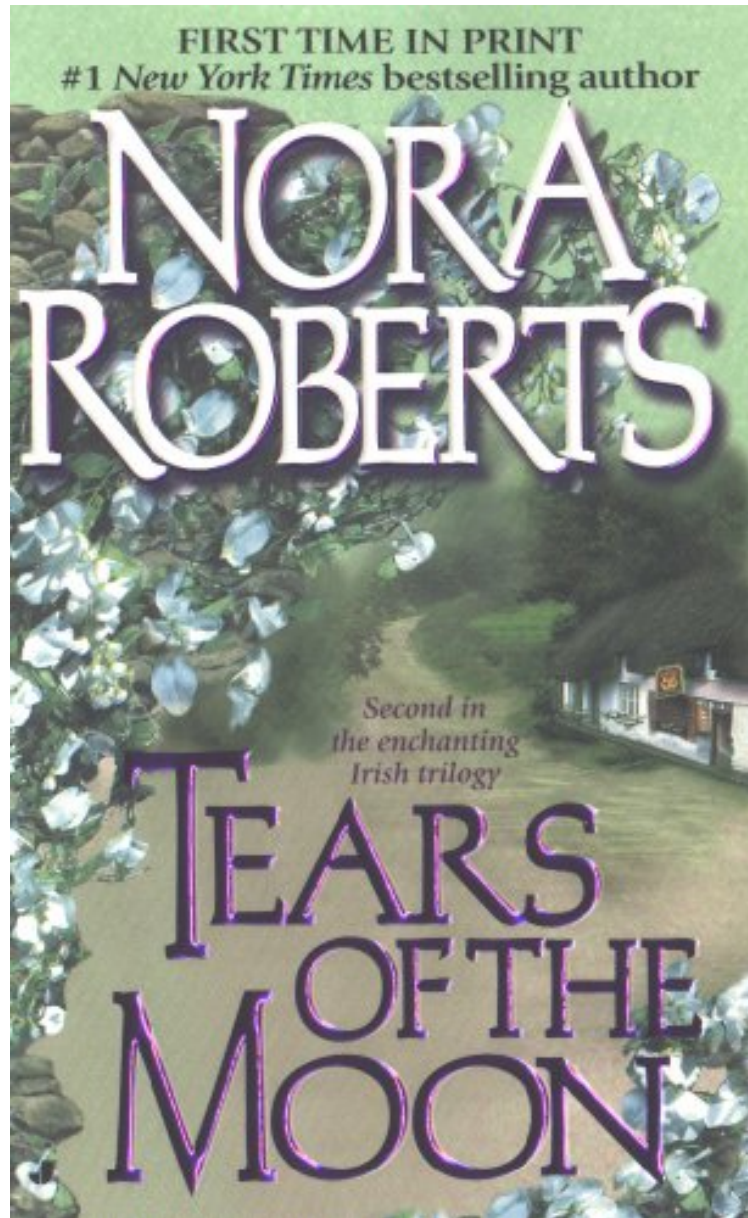

As you can imagine Brenna does not feel good about this 'rejection' and the story moves forward beautifully from there.Roberts plays with gender roles in Tears of the Moon and does a wonderful job of making her hero masculine even though he acts in a 'traditionally' feminine way. Roberts does the same for her heroine who loves to tinker with machines, build and design houses and could be considered 'romantically challenged'. They both however come across as balanced people even though gender roles have obviously been played with, perhaps precisely because of that.This is a magical, fun tale set in modern day Ireland. It is the second book in a three book series and all the original story lines are continued. Aiden and Jude have been married for a while and we are given a fun look into their life. The legend and meetings with the Fairy King continue and the end of the book introduces Darcy's love interest, ... sort of.
