I am a slow reader and I usually read for not more than half an hour before going to bed and therefore it usually would take me ages before I finish a book. Well, it only took me a few days with Tell

me. That damn book kept me awake and it not only got me laughing out loud more times than I can count, it also deeply touched me and even left me crying a couple of times - and I am actually one of these strong women! Its a character- and dialogue-driven story about about two quite different women who fall in love with each other, but realize that sometimes it takes a bit more than just love. Both struggle to come to terms with the fact that love also hurts and that they actually keep hurting each other. At some point both women have to choose which paths they want to take, even though it might lead away from each other. And they do choose. And it does hurt even more.
