Henry Page is a definitely a character which has started to go on my nerves with his childishness, so while the other characters are rather interesting - especially Val and Vi are nice characters to read about (and I often do not like female characters),

Mac and Henry are both on the run again this time from the OPR (Office of Professional Responsibility); they head back to Altona to Mac's parents hoping for some breathing room so Mac can discover who is setting him up. Henry has to decide if being with Mac is what he really wants, can he open his past to Mac or is keeping his true self hidden more important than the man he has come to begrudgingly love? As Mac fights to clear his name and Henry fights the demons of the past a ghost from the past rears its head and Mac and Henry wonder if they will get out alive. Oh hell now I never saw that coming and neither did Mac and Henry! Well guys this is definitely a fitting end to this great series, we get everything tied off brilliantly and we also get to see a wonderful end for Henry and Mac. This story picks up where *The Merchant of Death* ends with Mac, Henry and Viola heading for Mac's parents farm so Mac can regroup and try to figure what he should do next. We are introduced to a much more serious Henry as he examines his past and he tries to work out if he can chance admitting everything to Mac, he fears Mac will either walk away or try to make everything better and Henry can't decide which would be worse. Mac has his friend Val still on his side and as she investigates from within the FBI Mac hunts for information from his informants. We have a great time as Viola and Mac's family meet, Cory (Mac's niece) is a sweetheart she embraces a friendship with Viola and the two have an important part to play in this story. We discover who is behind Mac's troubles but not before trouble strikes again and the final showdown is fantastic! When Henry comes to terms with everything that has happened and his relationship with Mac his sparkling personality stomps back to life and has you chuckling, poor Mac LOL. This last instalment of the *Playing the Fool* series gets wrapped up brilliantly, everything gets tied up neatly and there are no loose ends left.
