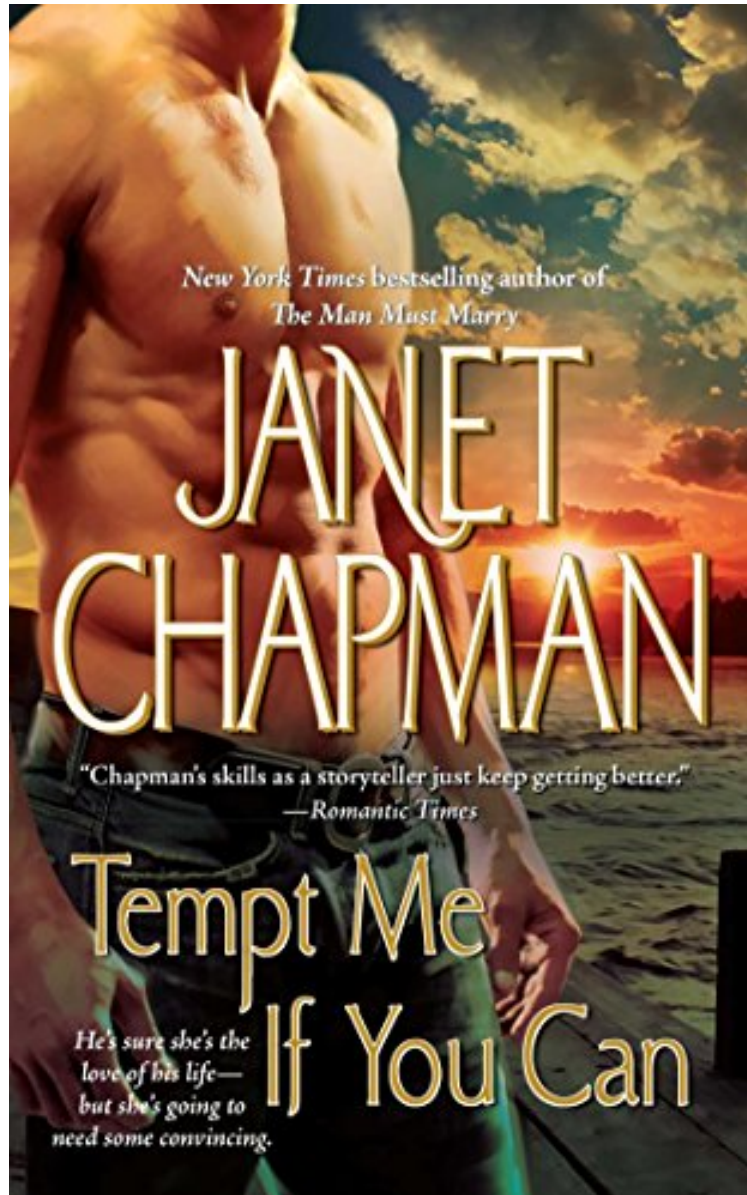

But the book also makes sense on its own, so if you

don't have 'The man must marry yet', it's not a big deal. One day, confirmed bachelor Ben Sinclair receives an anonymous letter telling him about the fact that he has a teenage son, Michael, from an affair 15 years ago. The kid's mother disappeared 5 years later and left Michael to be raised by his young aunt, Emma. At first Ben's angry at Emma for keeping his son from him, but then he finds out that the boy's mother, Kelly, claimed he left her knowing she was pregnant - which he didn't - and that everyone blamed him for a dam being blown up by an environmentalist group he used to work with. Seeing how much Emma loves his son and realising that she only wanted to protect Michael, he softens towards her - as does she towards him when it becomes clear that he was innocent. Soon, attraction and then love begin to develop between them, but the one who's really responsible for the tragedy 15 years ago is afraid of being caught at last and would do anything to stop this from happening. Soon, Emma's and Ben's lives are at risk... This is a romance novel with a lot of atmosphere, nice characters and a sense of humour. It's a feel-good book mostly, but it also has a good suspense plot.
