But we discover that it takes a special person to draw him out and we get a glimpse into his wonderful heart. We travel with Houston and Amelia on their journey, during which they form an emotional attachment to each other as well as to the reader and fall in love despite Houston's disfigurement. Lorraine Heath has a way of peeling away the layers like no one else. Since we get a glimpse into Houston's soul, his disfigurement becomes moot and he becomes more desirable in our eyes as well as Amelia's.
