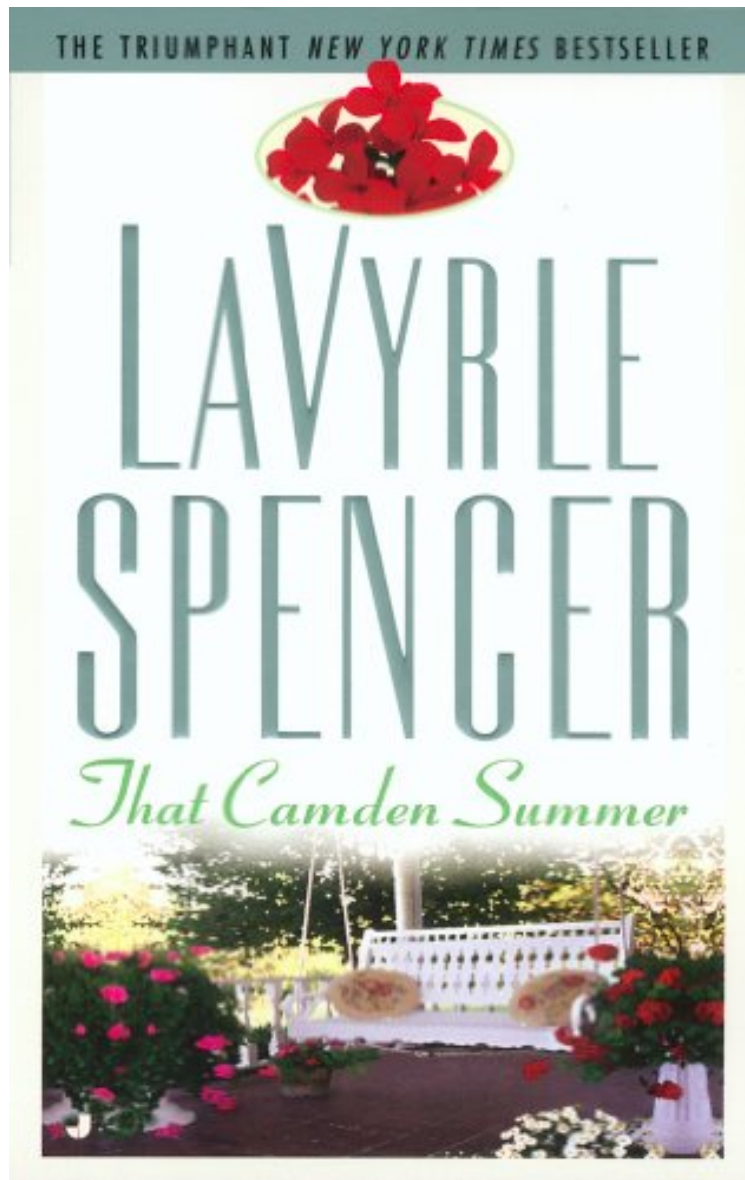

Roberta is criticized frequently for the divorce she had encountered only months earlier.
