that might sound strange, it leads to one of the greatest magic systems in urban fantasy: if you like "technobabble" in sci-fi, you'll love the "magicbabble" in this series - it even makes sense. Sometimes. The other thing this series does very well is interconnect the novels without using cliffhangers - one or two of the series do have them, but often there's some small hints that then are picked up in later novels and connect the series in such a way. It's very well done, better than in many series that are much higher regarded. Writing and proofreading is also generally very solid. No huge issues I spotted. Room for improvement, sure, but no huge complaints. The plots are OK. Fairly typical urban fantasy stuff, with some notable exceptions - perhaps lacking a bit of tension at times, but they work well enough. For most I suspect it's more about the fairly fun cast of characters and following them through the series; especially Ceri, the protagonist, who has a bit of "coming of age" aka "becoming an overpowered protagonist" journey ahead of her (it'll take some books though, so the Mary Sue factor isn't too crazy). So all that's perfectly fine, yet - and the rating can't really reflect this - the series has this ... thing with female characters being inevitably a certain way, and depending on your take on that it might completely ruin your enjoyment of the series. Now, urban fantasy often flirts with erotic elements and sometimes is outright erotica; this doesn't actually go all that far most of the time - lots of "fade outs". And with a succubus being a major character (the heroine's love interest) it's perfectly justified to be ... smutty. I'll even accept a certain amount of high heels, shirt skirts, and playing around with D/s elements. Succubi shouldn't be prude (they're fairly "vanilla" altogether nonetheless). Unfortunately the series has this idea that "female empowerment" means wearing weird fetish clothes in public, or joining werewolf orgies, or doing a porn flick, or working as a semi-exhibitionistic waitress and who knows what else. An ... interesting opinion, to say the least. Oh, and pretty much every woman in the series is bisexual. I wish there was a version with some of the dumber consequences of that ... opinion removed and the rest either polished so it makes sense or toned down to not be such a huge distraction. Alas, there's only this or nothing. I decided I'd rather read it nonetheless, but it's very much not something for everyone, no doubt. If you don't mind (or enjoy it), it's a solid urban fantasy series, though.
