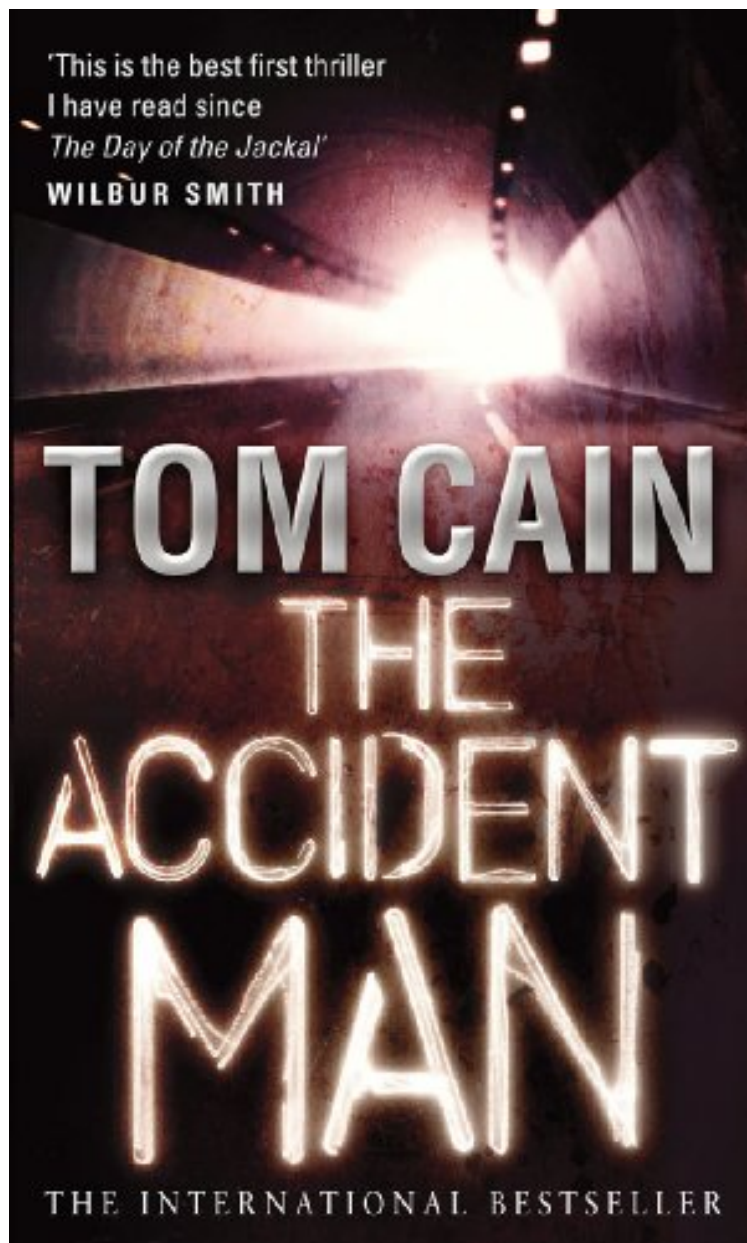

Schierer Some of the more lyrical reviews for this book and the Carver series in general lured me into buying this one. What can I say? I suppose it's not really my cup of tea. The premise is interesting enough, but the whole package never really lives up to the expectations speculative fiction should satisfy. The plot is somewhat predictable and the execution not really entertaining or in line with what the author is able to produce when he's setting his mind to it. I think in all fairness I will have to give the second Carver thriller a go, see if it appeals more to me. This definitely did not.
