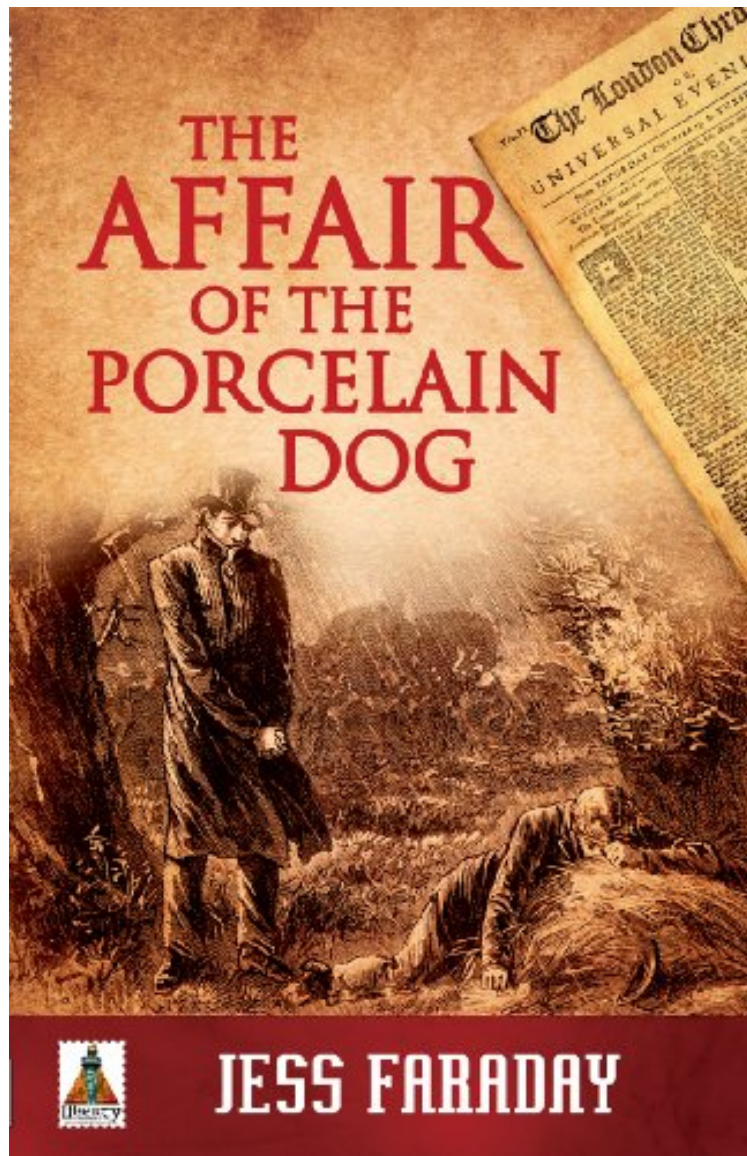

An atmospheric mystery set in Victorian London, giving a clear nod to Arthur Conan Doyle, but with enough own character development to be more than a mere pastiche.
