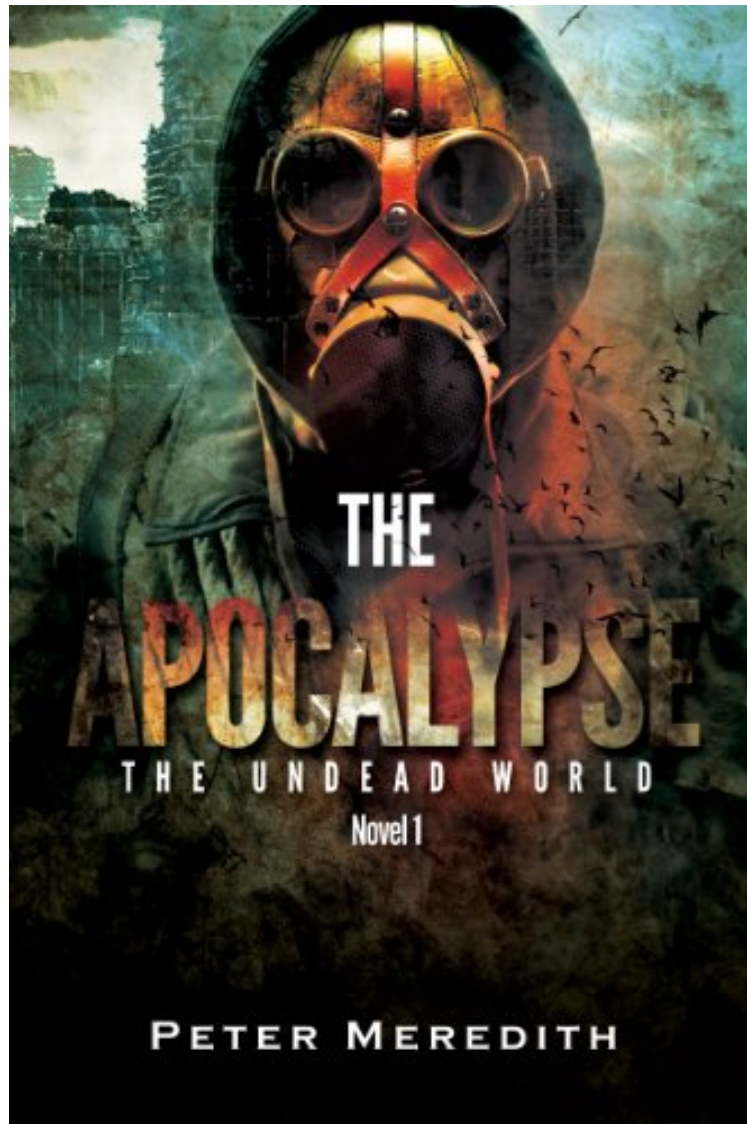

Thanks God for Kindle unlimited. 10 von 13 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. first kindle book i got a refund for Von scarlet rot i'm a very avid zombie / apocalypse fan. i'm pretty damn sure that i own more than 110 zombie books at this moment. i love my three b's - bloods, brains and bits. zombies, violence, gore - who doesn't love it? throw in some good dialogue, character development, gray morality and maybe a few not so stereotype situations and hell yeah, i'm game. sadly - this book had none of that. at all. instead you get some bad editing combined with sexist, racist, and homophobic bull. and this is putting it mildly. it's as if fox news is documenting the zombie apocalypse. the political bias is awfully strong in this one. after the (conveniently) black president apparently screws everything up - he is executed by the military which then turns into a bunch of plundering rapists. of course the only two female characters i've encountered so far pretty much just accepted the 'new role for women' as a given and so on. even the authors little 'warning' at the beginning is something i call bull on. you can write all those things - characters with a certain political or racist opinion, characters that are distinguished by where or how they grew up, characters that are rapists, characters with gray morality or just characters that make bad decisions in the worst situations. those kind of characters are what makes great fiction after all. but it's a huge problem if those kind of things don't just stay with that particular character but become the common theme of the entire book. the whole rape/sex for protection cr*p for example. there's a rather big difference between writing a rape scene to add to the book, to explain character development or just to illustrate how far the world has fallen - or almost glorifying it in a rather disturbing and disgusting way and having it repeat every few chapters. then again, the author already showed that he had no class at all when he decided to bash trailblazer's from the zombie genre in his little passive-aggressive opening statement. very well done. not to mention - which author actually goes to rate his own book at goodreads with a 5/5. i guess there's people that can work with criticism and actually use it to improve and then there's others. that all being said - thank god i could still return the book for a refund. i've read bad zombie books, but this was one of the worst and first that i returned - and never actually finished because it was so damn awful and disgusting, sadly just not in a good way.
