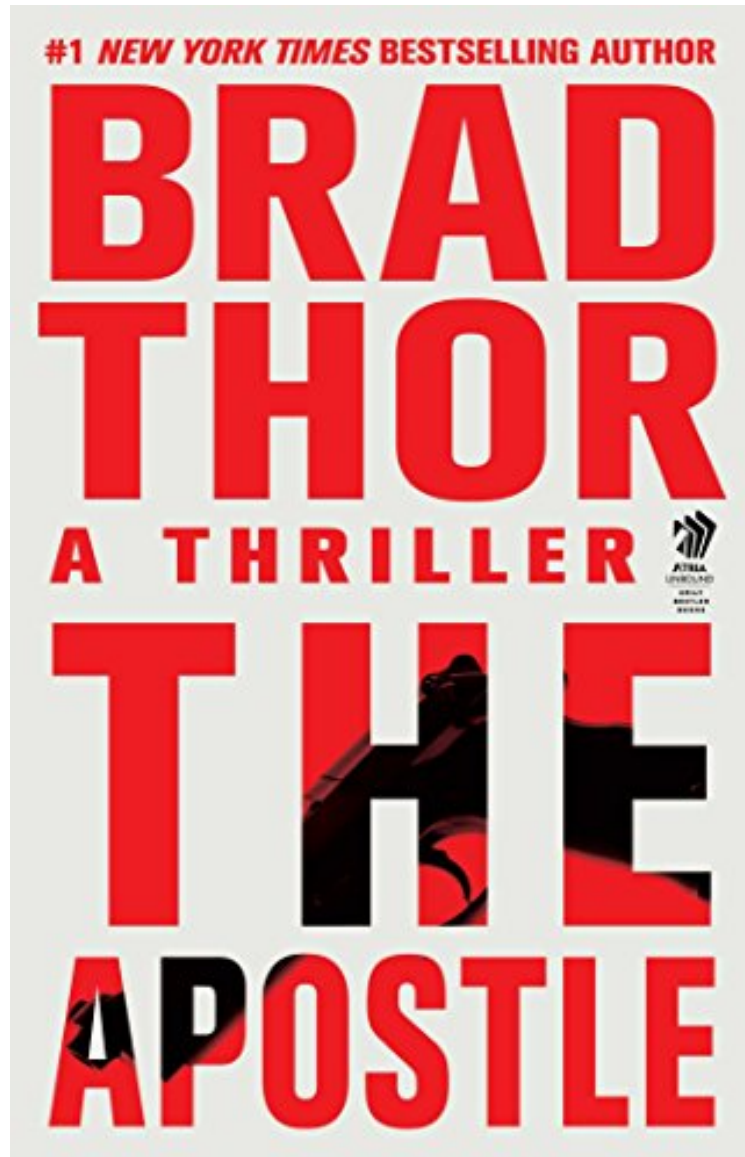

forward Von CF Julia Gallo, the daughter of a rich American business-woman, is held hostage in Afghanistan by an al-Qaida-operative. He wants to free another al-Qaida-Fighter - going by the name of Khan -, who is a prisoner of the Afghans, in exchange for Julia Gallo. The POTUS made contact between Scot Harvath - an ex-marine and a real "cowboy" - and the mother of Julia Gallo. She gave Harvath the task to free Khan and exchange him for her daughter Julia. Harvath flew to Afghanistan and was able to free Khan with the help of friends and some Afghan police and service members. But when he saw Khan, he was sure he didn't want to exchange him for Julia. He wanted to free Julia and gave Khan in custody with the Americans. That's the basic story of this book. There is another story about the president and a lethal injured female secret service agent. But this story has no effect on the real story about Harvath. And I didn't know, why Thor wrote about this. It's not very exciting and it didn't bring the other story forward. But the main story was exciting and thrilling. Thor wrote about a man you could compare with Lee Child's Jack Reacher. But Harvath didn't just see the world in black and white, like Reacher did. No, he knows the colors between black and white... all the different grey scales. Thor developed a manifold person, who knew what was right and who knew how to reach his goal. But he is not a lone rider, he believes in friends. And so Thor developed some other individuals for the story. Beyond that he wrote about the Afghan mentality, the status of the villages and the elders in those communities. He wrote about feuds between the villages, about *bakhshich* and about friendship to foreigners, how it should be.
