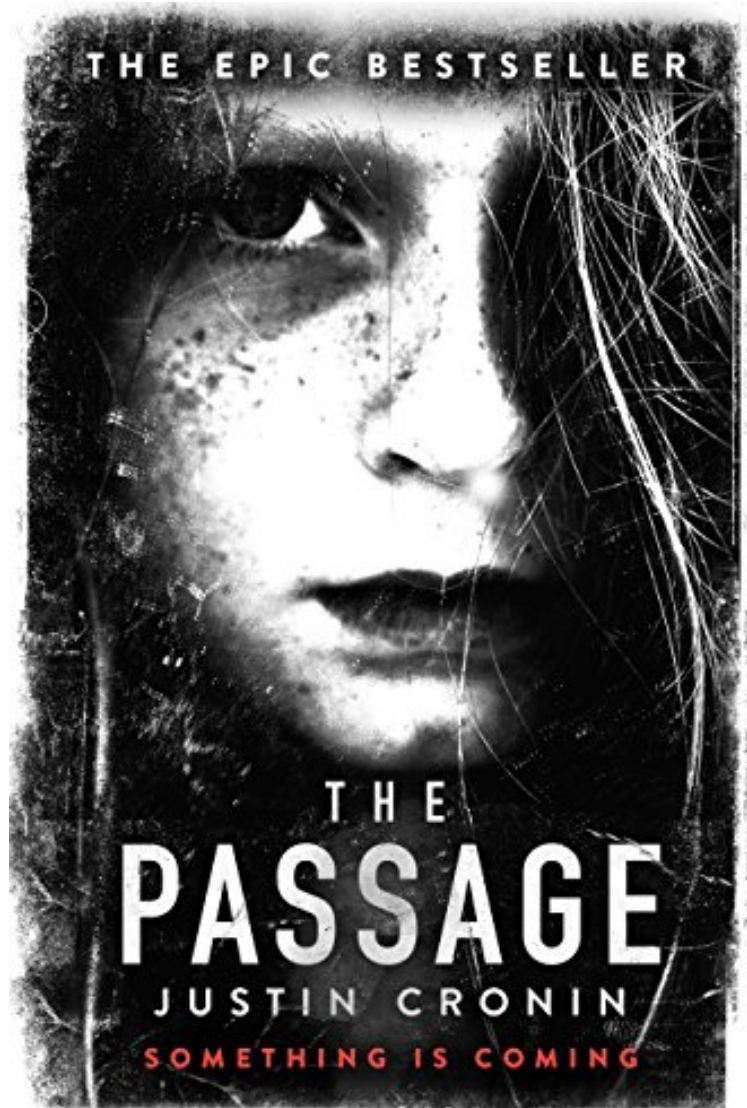

When you look at Mr. Cronin's background it comes as no surprise that this novel is both structurally and stylishly so much more than just your Humans vs. Vampires 101 story. The author juggles with a lot of topics so that it's sometimes hard to decide where he intended to put the emphasis on. There's your post-apocalyptic wasteland world in which people have to build closed-off colonies where they are forced to establish a whole new society order with a new constitution. The human interactions inside this new society are observed with great detail so that this alone would have made an interesting book sans the outside Vampire threat. There's also some action and the bloodsuckers are as they should be, lethal, scary and thirsty so don't expect any Twilight nonsense. Maybe a few passages contained a bit too much philosophical tendencies and religious innuendo but in a world without hope this might come natural. Another good move was that the story really evolves and the settings are constantly changed in effect that the main characters have to face different situations again and again. I really can't wait to read the sequel because there are so many hints to incidents that happened previously which are not explained further. Cleverly done, Mr. Cronin. By the way, in the Acknowledgements section the author explains how he actually came to write the book in the first place which is really interesting as well so I urge any reader to take the time and devour those lines after having finished this novel.
