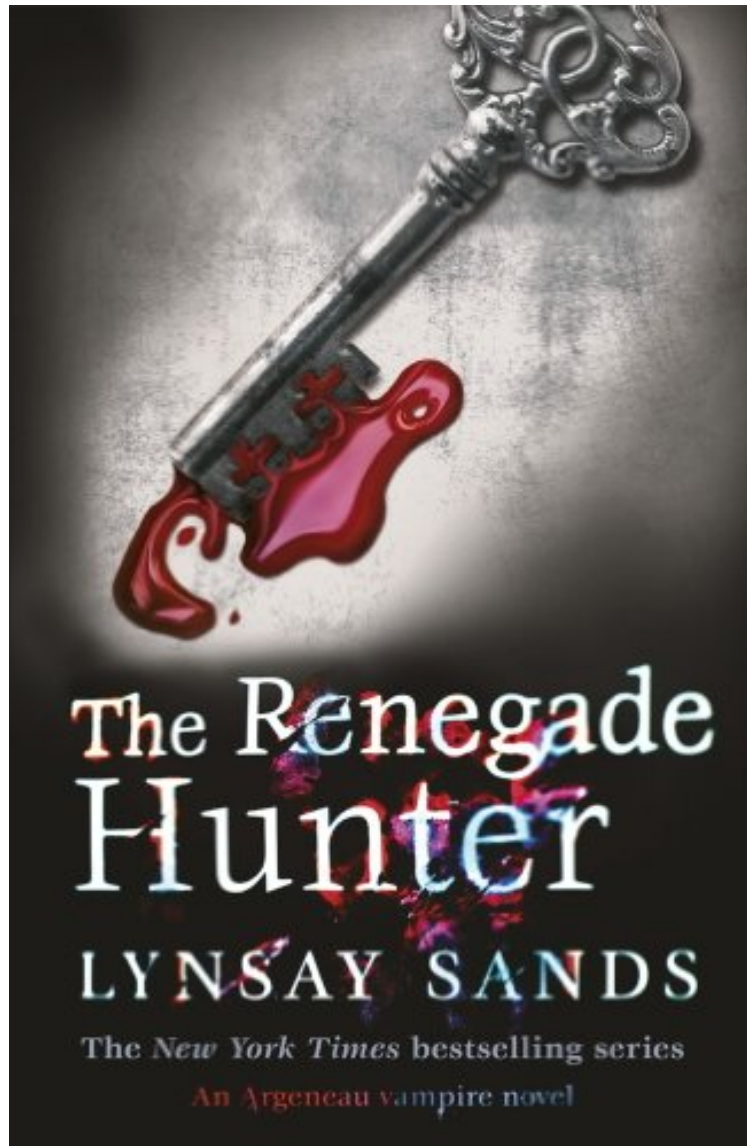

funVon CorneliaDies hier ist der dritte Band von Lynsay Sands, und ich frage mich ob die Autorin wirklich alle Bnde selbst schreibt - das Niveau schwankt so sehr dass es fr mich kaum nachzuvollziehen ist, wie jemand so gute und soooo schlechte Geschichten schreiben kann.Diese Geschichte ist zum Glck eine der guten, und ich konnte mich gut davon unterhalten lassen. Die Handlung beginnt kurz nach dem Ende von Immortal Hunter, und die Hauptperson ist die einzige, die mich beim Immortal Hunter interessiert hat: Nicholas Argeneau, ein ehemaliger Rogue-Hunter, der jetzt selbst seit fnfzig Jahren auf der Flucht ist nachdem er aus Kummer ber den gewaltsamen Tod seines schwangeren Lifemates eine andere Schwangere ermordet hat.Die Handlung ist dicht gepackt, wenig brutal, wenig sadistisch (damit hatte ich beim Immortal Hunter so meine Probleme, weswegen ich mich ber weite Teile des Buches nicht wirklich entspannen konnte weil ich immer auf eine weitere Entfhrung gelauert habe), und vor allem mit einer glaubwrdigen Liebesgeschichte und einer sehr liebenswerten weiblichen Hauptfigur, Jo.Die Law-Enforcers sind wie immer total unfhig, die Frauen selbstbewusst, und die Auflsung total unbefriedigend - der Fall wird gelst ohne dass man erfhrt wie und warum. Nur im Epilog ein "so Ihr Lieben, nun lebt man froh und glcklich miteinander", was mich relativ unbeeindruckt gelassen hat. Viele Autoren haben ein Handlungsstrickmuster, man denke an J.R. Ward, oder an Stephanie Laurens, und hier ist das auch so, aber dennoch variieren die Bcher im Ton und im Charakter der Hauptpersonen - sonst wre dies hier wohl mein letzter Band der Argeneau-Vampire geworden. Jo Willan finds herself taking some fresh air at a party and is then unexpectedly attacked by an unknown man. She fights back but is soon rescued by another man, Nicholas Argeneau, who is on the run. Nicholas is a 'rogue', a vampire who has killed a mortal, and has been hiding from the hunters for fifty years.But Nicholas recognises Jo as his lifemate and can't keep away, especially when Jo is being targeted by Ernie, another rogue. Nicholas tries to keep Jo safe which seems to involve them being on the run together. But why did Nicholas commit murder, and is there more to the story of his past than Jo or even he realises?I enjoyed reading this story which focused very strongly on the relationship between Nicholas and Jo; they are together in almost every scene and we follow their conversations as they get to know each other. However I was left with the overwhelming feeling that, having read one Lynsay Sands Argeneau vampire series book, you've really read them all. The underlying story was very familiar and when lots of other vampire characters appeared in this book, along with their lifemates, I realised that I couldn't separate them in my mind - their stories had all merged, because they were so similar. I also found the end of the book rather disappointing as we aren't told what actually happened to Nicholas when he was found with the murdered woman; presumably this will be revealed in a future book but it meant that this one didn't feel complete.Despite the large list of supporting vampire characters, the focus on Nicholas and Jo means that this book can be read by those who haven't read any others.
