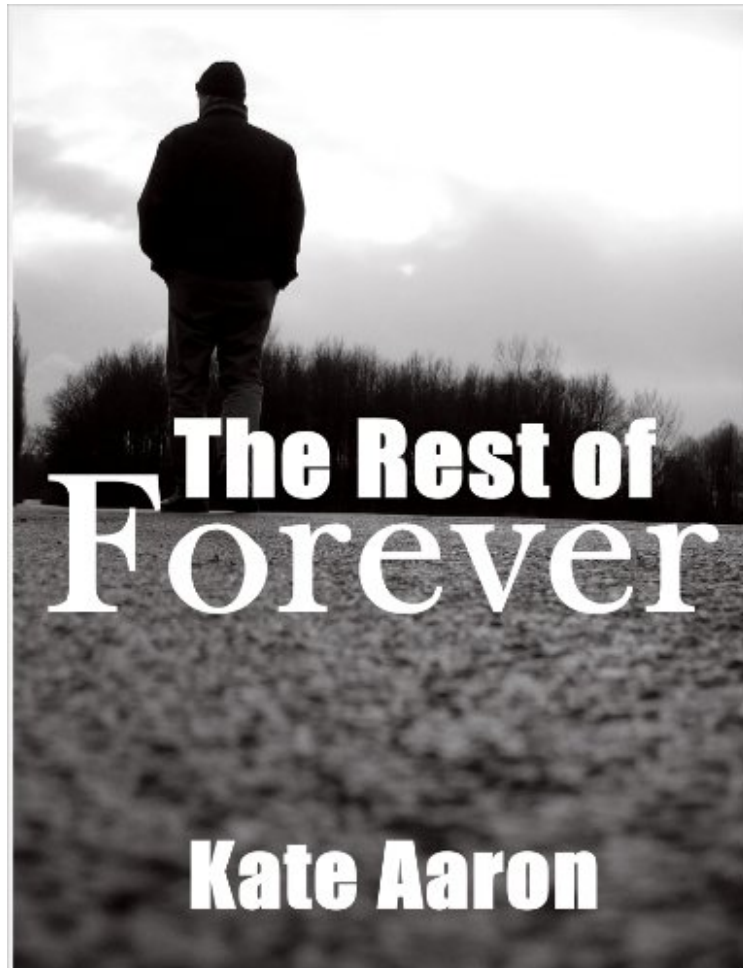

I thoroughly enjoyed Ms Aaron's writing style and all the angst she put into her story. Jack realizes far too late that he loves Paul, and goes (quite deservedly) through hell for it. Although I love all the tension and desperation Jack goes through I did wonder at one point if he goes a bit over the top. He does say repeatedly he doesn't deserve Paul's love and forgiveness, but he's still hell bent on getting him back - even if common sense tells him not to pursue a man who's in a relationship. That is actually the one thing that made me uneasy. Paul seems to be very ready to break up with a man he's supposedly 'happy' with. No wonder Curtis is mad at Jack. I really would have loved to hear the story from Paul's point of view. Was he resigned to live a life with Curtis although he didn't love

him? On what grounds did he decide to go back to Jack? A man who's been leading a totally promiscuous lifestyle? I would have loved to read a 'long' version of this, with both POVs and some more complications before Jack and Paul find each other again. This however, did not take away from my enjoyment of this story.
