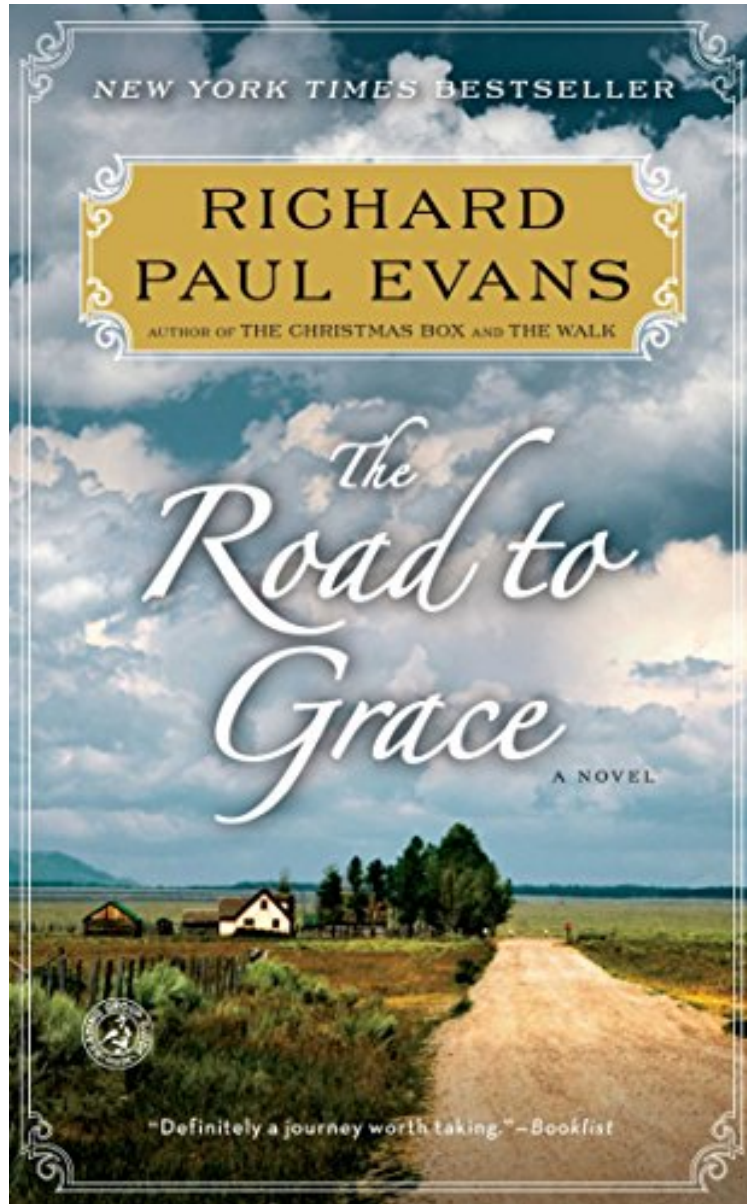

Zwar wird der Leser darauf hingewiesen, dass Alan einfach alles hinter sich lässt, aber die entscheidenden Dinge nimmt er erst mal mit auf seinen Weg. Ratlosigkeit, Bitterkeit und Verlorenheit begleiten ihn ein ganzes Stück auf seinem Weg. Es braucht die Begegnungen mit anderen Menschen, damit Alan lernt, zu vergeben, sich selbst und anderen. Sein Schicksal anzunehmen ist nicht einfach und es braucht mehr als nur Kilometer, damit er das schafft. Richard Paul Evans hat ein leises Buch geschrieben.
