This is the reason why I bought the "Scarletti Curse". Unfortunately, it was one of the worst books I ever read. I kept losing interest about what happened to hero and heroine after the first third of the book. Their characters were so poorly developed - I did like neither of them. And I got very annoyed with the characters of other people in the book - like the ever praying Maria Pia and the sister of the hero - I have even forgotten the names now! I would also recommend that the author should try to use Italian names, when the stage of the story is supposed to be Italy, or Spanish names, when it is supposed to happen in Spain. The worst is to choose fantasy name with English roots. As for the foreign language parts: Please decide in which language you let hero/heroine speak - don't mix Italian with Spanish and also try to get them grammatically right! The story itself is very predictable and a dull repetition of what the author has written in the "Dark Series". I was so disappointed and I was glad when I finished it. The first problems were the main characters: I could not warm myself to neither hero or heroine - they were described in a way that I lost interest in what happens to them at the beginning. The second problem were the side characters: I got so annoyed with this Maria Pia lady and her permanent praying and crossing and I found a lot of other characters quite irritating. The entire plot of the story was so boring - it looks like the writer just wanted to write another story but lacked any ideas. By reading it you get the feeling that just something is made up to fill the pages - this is a fact which should not be obvious when reading a book, even if it is complete fantasy. This time Christine did not make the reader believe that such a story could happen. And another advise for the writer: the non-English sentences and verbs are a mix between Italian and Spanish language and a lot of the expressions are wrong. Try to get these ones right before publishing the book - even try to use names who sound either Spanish or Italian if the story plays there but don't use English-sounding "made-up"ones! Last but not least: The so-called "famous sex scenes" in this book made me yawn and they are almost a word to word repetition of the ones described in the "Dark Series" - this is why I yawned because I have read them already!
